1. Safety Instructions

These safety instructions must be followed to ensure your safety and prevent property damage.

Warning/Cautions otherwise, it may result in personal injury or property damage.

Make sure to read the instructions carefully and use the product in the correct manner.

1. Power adapter:

IMPUT:100V-220VAC

0.5A 47-63Hz

OUTPUT:12V 1.25A


2. Do not place 70-CT in a location exposed to moisture, dust, smoke, water, or in a car.

Otherwise, this may result in electric shock or fire.

- 3. Clean the product using a soft cloth with a monitor cleaner only. Ensure that water does not enter the product and that it is not wet. Otherwise, this may result in electric shock, fire or a malfunction.
- Do not force on LCD Screen
 Do not tap or scratch LCD Screen with a sharp object.
 Otherwise, LCD may get damaged.
- 5. Product Input/Output Connectors Do not insert any metal, such as chopsticks, coins, pins and steel of foreign material enters the product. Otherwise disconnect the adapter cable and contact a Service Center.
- 6. Do not install 70-CT in an unstable location.

1. No picture on screen

- a. Check the AC cord and signal cable. Make sure they are properly connected.
- b. Check if the computer has entered energy saving mode.

2. Abnormal display color

Check if the signal cable is properly connected to the computer.

3: How can I clean the outer case/LCD Panel?

Disconnect the VGA/D-Sub cable and then clean the 70-CT with a soft cloth Do not leave any detergent or scratches on the case. Do not let any water enter the monitor.
